

EARLY GRADUATION PROPOSAL

1. To be eligible for Early Graduation, a student must have completed a minimum of **29** credits. These credit include:
 - a. **Four** credits in English (Language Arts – 2 terms, English 10A, 10B, and 10C, English 11, a literature course, plus another English course)
 - b. **Three** credits in Mathematics (any courses)
 - c. **Three** credits in Social Studies (American History – 2 terms, World History – 2 terms, Economics, Government)
 - d. **Three** credits in Science (Biology – 3 terms & General Science A, B & C.
 - e. **Two** credits in Physical Education
 - f. **One half** credit for Computer Workplace Skills
 - g. **13.5** elective credits
2. Students wanting to graduate early must submit this proposal to the guidance office.
3. Applications will be reviewed and recommendation sent to V-S school board.
4. Applicants will be notified of board decision by the guidance counselor.
5. Early graduates may participate in Prom and the graduation ceremony. They may NOT participate in any other student activities (ie. Sr. Class Trip, athletics, speech, etc.) once their early graduation date has passed.

Generally, students will be required to complete the necessary course work and graduate from high school at the end of grade twelve. Student may graduate prior to this time if they meet the minimum graduation requirements stated in board policy. In such cases, the student must have the approval of the board and a recommendation from the superintendent and the high school principal.

A student who graduates early will no longer be considered a student and will become an alumnus of the school district. Students who begin the next trimester after early graduation has been approved, waive their right to early graduation and must re-apply. However, the student who graduates early may participate in commencement exercises and may attend prom.
